Nordic Sensi®Chair is a non-pharmalogical aid for stimulation of the senses. It is suitable for patients who present with restless or externalising behaviour, pain, mental imbalance or delirium. The Nordic Sensi®Chair's gentle rocking motions combined with bass vibrations and soothing music helps patients to rest and unwind.

Use of the Nordic Sensi®Chair's three sensory rocking motion programs is accompanied by calming music from MusiCure®, produced by musician and composer Niels Eje. The music, the de-stressing and calming effect of which has been documented, was composed specifically for the aforementioned purpose.

The chair is used to bring calm to patients who present with restless and externalising behaviours, who are in pain, and to shorten their state of delirium. It is also used to stimulate increased arousal in more passive patients as they wake up.

Nordic Sensi®Chair is used at a number of different hospitals in Denmark, e.g. Rigshospitalet in Copenhagen, University Hospitals in Odense, Svendborg, and Glostrup. While typically used to increase consciousness and reduce unrest, whether motor or mental, the stimuli from the chair can also be used for delirium, sleep problems and behavioural issues.




The leg positioner is optional accessory for the chair.



The AUX port makes it possible to connect an external music source for instance a smartphone or tablet.




The armrests on the chair can be opened or removed to make getting in and out easier. This will ensure safety, as well as improving working conditions.



Four lockable dual wheels make the chair stable, both during transportation and use. The clearance makes use of mobile personal hoists possible.



The remote control comes with a spiral cable, which prevents it being removed and lost.



The 6 cm-thick mattress, meanwhile, is made from viscoelastic, dual-component foam, which distributes the pressure evenly, ensuring a high level of comfort.



The elasticated cover, with internal stitching, wraps in place around the mattress.



A positioning kit, consisting of four wedges and a leg roller plus strap, ensures the patient is positioned correctly, as well as making it safe and stable. Available as an optional accessory.
